General guidelines for nominations :



The Laurel F. Jacobs, Achievement Award was re-named in March 1995 for former CPARC consumer, Laurel Jacobs, who is now deceased.

Nominees should be a person or group of people who have met challenges, overcome difficulties, and gone on to lead lives which inspire others. Nominees may include CPARC consumers, staff or volunteers.

A maximum of four (4) Winners will be selected. A group nomination will be considered as one winner.

The Luther S. Beers, Distinguished Service Award is given annually to a deserving volunteer or group. Mr. Beers was one of the founders of CPARC, and was the first "president" of what is now known as the S. Wilson Pollock Center for Industrial Training.



As a volunteer, Mr. Beers worked tirelessly for the rights of individuals with intellectual disabilities. Upon his death, CPARC established the Luther S. Beers, Distinguished Service Award in recognition of his many years of outstanding service.

Nominees should be individuals who have given unselfishly of their time and talents in furthering the rights of individuals with special needs, and who exemplify volunteerism.
